One of television's most prolific directors and producers, Asaad Kelada has directed over 600 episodes for all the major networks, and was series director for the hit series Two and a Half Men, The Facts of Life, Who's the Boss?, WKRP in Cincinnati, Dharma and Greg, Everybody Loves Raymond, The Office, The Last Resort, Frannie's Turn, Married People, George, In the House, and Sister Sister, among many others. He also directed the pilots for several new network series, including those for Family Ties, The Last Resort, Report to Murphy, Bureau, Married People, George as well as Two and a Half Men. Born in Cairo, Egypt, Kelada came to the United States in 1961 to pursue graduate studies at Yale University School of Drama.
